## Items Discussed:

- 1. Cash Balance as of October 31, 2025, the cash balance is \$74,512.
- 2. 2025 Maintenance Fee.
  - We have collected \$57,835 as of September 30, 2025, of the fees billed in January. We billed \$67,410 at the rate of \$210. Most of the homeowners have paid at the discount rate.
  - We have \$2,765 as of September 30, 2025, outstanding in uncollected 2025 maintenance fees.
  - Uncollected accounts will be taken to the District Justice later this year. The next step is filing with the Prothonotary for a lien to be placed.
- 3. Prior Year Maintenance Fees.
  - We have \$2,410 in past due prior year fees (2015-2025), which represents a single homeowner. Leins have been filed against the homeowner with multiple year delinquency.
- 4. Real Estate Taxes have been paid in full for the year 2025. All taxes were paid in the discount period.
- 5. 2025 Projects:
  - Wind Screens. Wind Screens to be placed on the tennis court fence again by Keystone Staff in June. Mini carabiners to hold the windbreaker down better.

- Seal Coat and crack fill the walking path completed
- Painting of the merry go round
- 6. Budget for 2026 approved.
  - Fees to remain the same
  - \$185 for January 1 February 28th, 2026
  - Fees increase to \$210, March 1st, 2026
- 7. Websites provided for research into playground equipment:

- 8. Wind guards and net at the tennis court should be removed December 1<sup>st</sup> and reinstalled March 1<sup>st</sup>. To be stored in the storage bin on the court.
- 9. Walking path tree roots. Should this be pursued by cutting the walking path and removing the roots. Roots were cut back a few years ago by the landscaper. There is not a huge tripping issue, leave the path as is.
- 10. Next meeting to be scheduled in April/May 2026.
